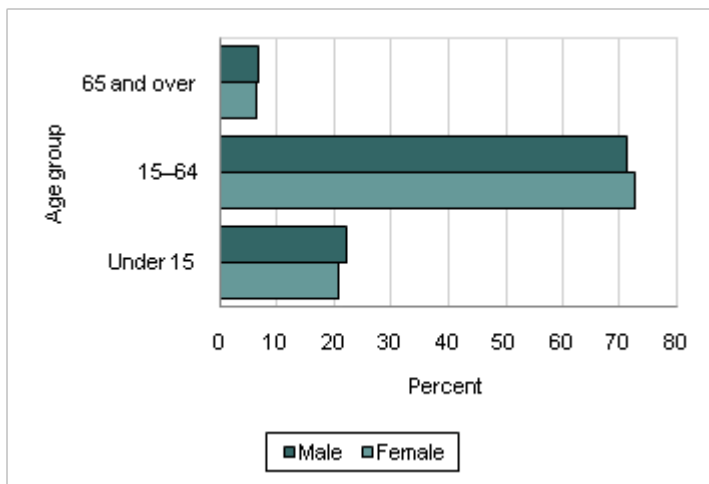
Age & sex

Total population

- 6.6 percent of people in Piha/Karekare are aged 65 years and over, compared with 9.9 percent of the total Auckland Region population.
- 21.4 percent of people are aged under 15 years in Piha/Karekare, compared with 22.1 percent for all of Auckland Region.

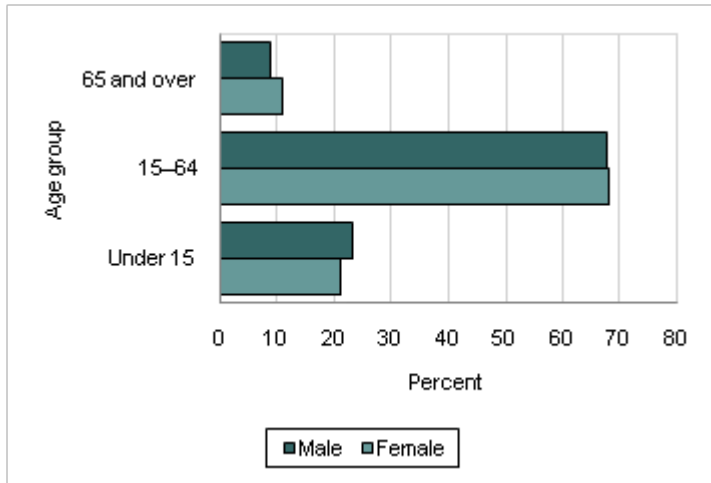
Age Group and Sex

Birthplace

- 20.0 percent of people in Piha/Karekare were born overseas, compared with 37.0 percent for Auckland Region as a whole.
- For people born overseas who are now living in Piha/Karekare, the most common birthplace was the UK and Ireland, compared with Asia for all of Auckland Region.

Languages spoken

- English is the most commonly spoken language in Piha/Karekare.
- 2.6 percent of people in Piha/Karekare speak Māori, compared with 2.7 percent of people for all of Auckland Region.
- New Zealand Sign Language is used by 0.5 percent of people in Piha/Karekare, compared with 0.6 percent of people for all of Auckland Region.
- 85.5 percent of people in Piha/Karekare speak only one language, compared with 70.7 percent of people for all of Auckland Region.

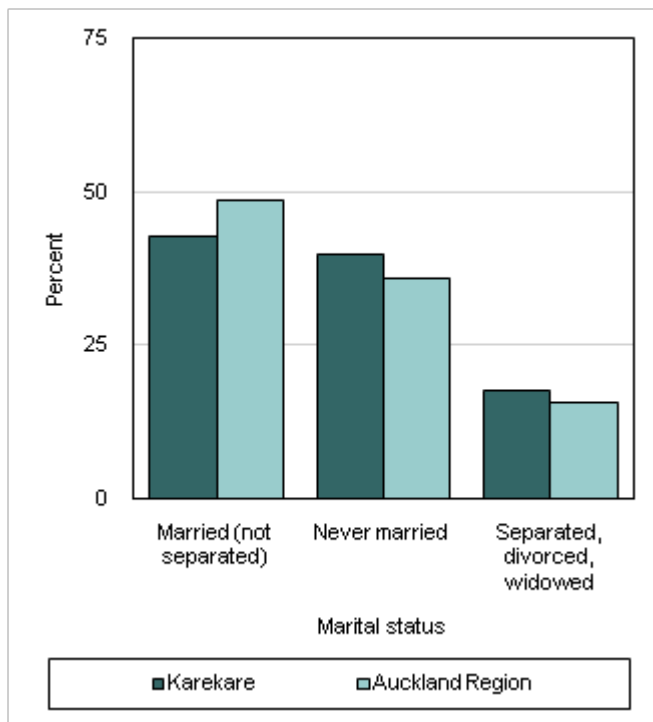
Marital status

Total population aged 15 years and over

- 39.7 percent of people aged 15 years and over living in Piha/Karekare have never married, 42.8 percent are married, and 17.5 percent are separated, divorced or widowed.
- 43.7 percent of people aged 15 years and over in Piha/Karekare who have never married, live with a partner.

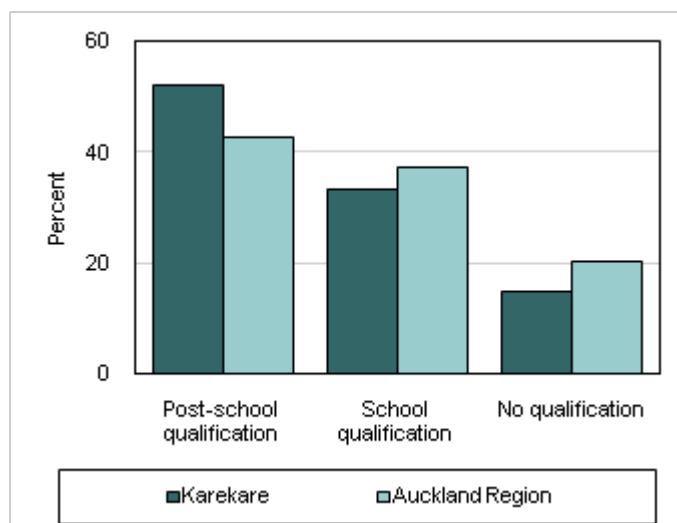
Education

Total population aged 15 years and over

- 52.1 percent of people aged 15 years and over in Piha/Karekare have a post-school qualification, compared with 42.5 percent of people throughout Auckland Region.
- In Piha/Karekare, 14.8 percent of people aged 15 years and over have no formal qualifications, compared with 20.3 percent for Auckland Region as a whole.

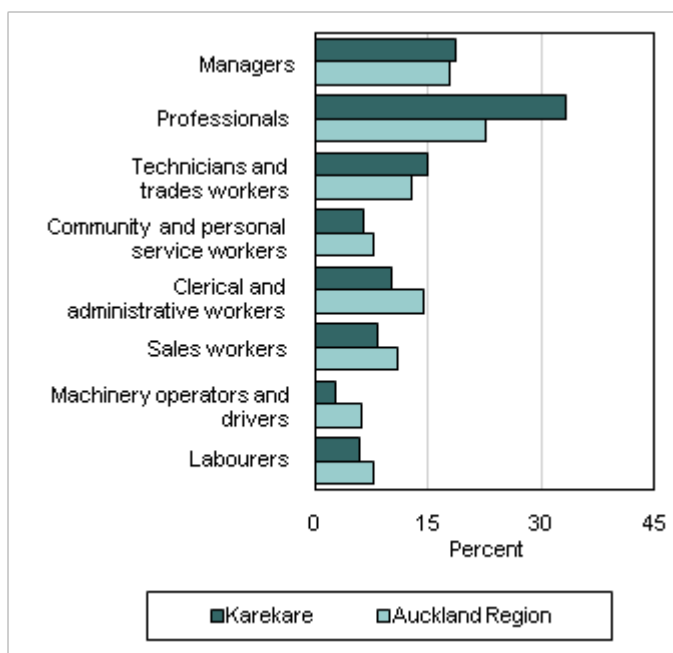
Work

Total population aged 15 years and over

- The unemployment rate in piha/Karekare is 3.9 percent for people aged 15 years and over, compared with 5.6 percent for all of Auckland Region.
- The most common occupational group in Piha/Karekare is 'Professionals' and 'Professionals' is the most common occupational group in Auckland Region.

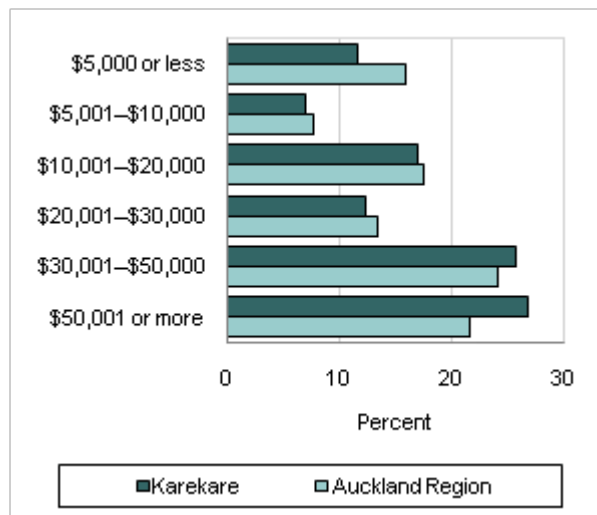
Income

Total population aged 15 years and over

- For people aged 15 years and over, the median income (half earn more, and half less, than this amount) in Piha/Karekare is \$31,600. This compares with a median of \$26,800 for all of Auckland Region.
- 35.3 percent of people aged 15 years and over in Piha/Karekare have an annual income of \$20,000 or less, compared with 40.9 percent of people for Auckland Region as a whole.
- In Piha/Karekare, 26.7 percent of people aged 15 years and over have an annual income of more than \$50,000, compared with 21.6 percent of people in Auckland Region.

Piha/Karekare

Families

- Couples with children make up 44.6 percent of all families in Piha/Karekare, while couples without children make up 40.5 percent of all families.
- In Auckland Region, couples with children make up 46.3 percent of all families, while couples without children make up 34.8 percent of all families.
- 14.9 percent of families in Piha/Karekare are one-parent-with-children families, compared with 18.9 percent of families for Auckland Region as a whole.

Piha/Karekare

Households

- One-family households make up 69.1 percent of all households in Piha/Karekare. For Auckland Region as a whole, one-family households make up 70.3 percent of all households.
- 240 people (or 26.1 percent) live in one-person households in Piha/Karekare. Throughout Auckland Region, one-person households make up 19.6 percent of all households.
- The average household size in Piha/Karekare is 2.5 people, compared with an average of 2.9 people for all of Auckland Region.

Phones, net & fax

Households

- 71.1 percent of households in Piha/Karekare have access to the Internet, compared with 65.5 percent of households throughout Auckland Region.
- In Piha/Karekare 58.7 percent of households have access to a cellphone, compared with 76.4 percent of households for Auckland Region as a whole.

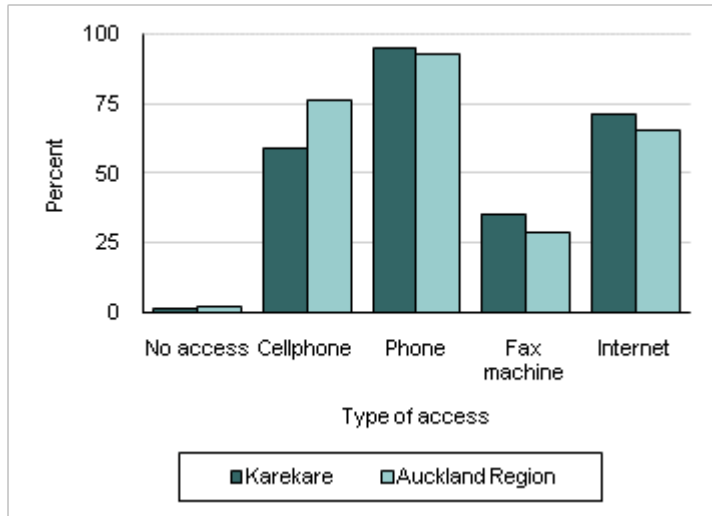

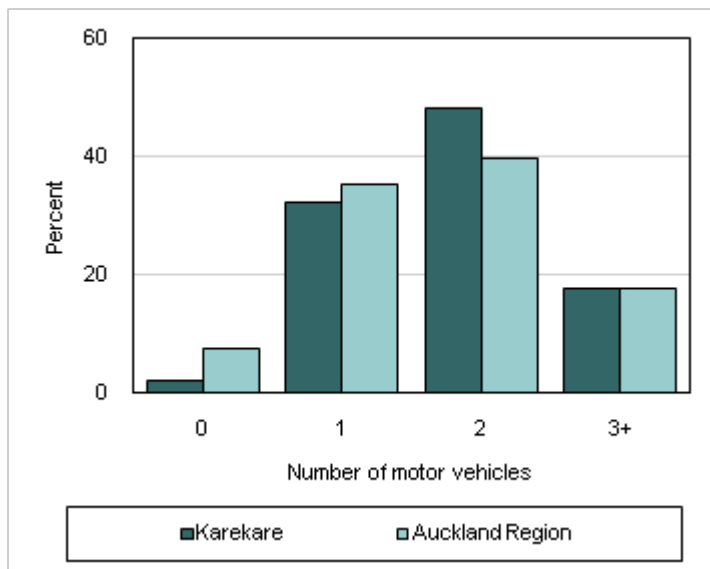
Transport

Household access to motor vehicles

- 17.8 percent of households in Piha/Karekare have access to three or more motor vehicles, compared with 17.7 percent of all households in Auckland Region.

Main means of travel to work

- Excluding driving a private car, truck or van, the second most common means of travel to work on census day for people in Piha/Karekare was driving a company car, truck or van. For Auckland Region as a whole, the second most common means of travel to work was driving a company car, truck or van.

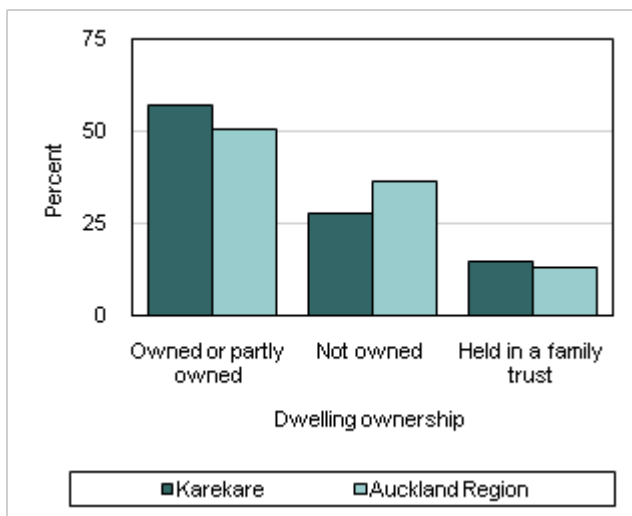
Housing

- In Piha/Karekare, 57.0 percent of households in private occupied dwellings own the dwelling, with or without a mortgage.
- For Auckland Region as a whole, 50.7 percent of households in private occupied dwellings own the dwelling, with or without a mortgage.
